Tournament Rules & Format

All players will play 18 holes both Saturday & Sunday (36 hole event) All players will compete in the individual and teams' events over 36 holes All players are to arrive at least 30 minutes prior to their tee time Each round will be recorded via GolfLink for handicapping

- All players are expected to abide to the athlete code of conduct
- All players MUST carry & use a sand bucket at the host venues
- All players MUST respect the host venues and repair all divots & pitch marks
- All players MUST hit a provisional ball if unsure of the original ball's location
- All players MUST keep up with the group in front of them
- All players MUST Check the host venues Local Rules Board/Card

All players MUST report to the tournament desk at the start and end of play

Athlete Information

Preparation

- On site warm up facilities available on course (hitting nets, putting greens, chipping greens)
- Athletes are encouraged to ensure sufficient fluid intake prior to, during and post matches.
- All athletes are required to wear their relevant Academy uniform and appropriate oncourse attire to meet club requirements during play.

Injuries

- Academy Squads are advised to <u>bring their own supplies of ICE, strapping,</u> <u>bandages etc.</u>
- All injuries should be reported by athletes to Tournament Organiser at the conclusion of games. Team officials are responsible for the transport, treatment and care of their injured athletes.

Spirit of Play

- All athletes and officials are expected to observe the "spirit of sport " requirements when participating in the Games, and adhere to the Academies' Code of Conduct as well as general Golf etiquette.
- Athletes who do not observe these fundamental requirements will not be permitted to participate further in the Games.

Officials

- Persons officiating during the Academy Games are doing so as Volunteers and are committed to assisting our athletes enjoy their participation in the Games. Officials are to be treated at all times with courtesy and respect.
- Abuse of match or tournament officials will not be tolerated at any time.
