Games Format

Competition Format

Boys and Girls Competition.

Stage 1 - Round Robin

Each team will play in a round robin format allocated into two pools (Pool A or Pool B). Pool A will play each team within their pool once to determine a pool *placing* of 1st through 5th.

Pool B will play each team within their pool once to determine a pool ranking of 1st through 4th.

Stage 2 - Play in Games (*Pool B Only*)

To equalise the number of games played throughout the round robin stage, teams in Pool B will play an additional Play In game to determine the final pool *placings*. 1st in Pool B will play 2nd in Pool B, and 3rd in Pool B will play 4th in Pool B. The winners of these games will be *placed* 1st and 3rd in Pool B, with the losers *placed* 2nd and 4th respectively.



Stage 3 - Playoffs

Following the completion of the round robin, teams *placed* 1st and 2nd in each pool will proceed to a crossover Semi Final, where 1st in Pool A will play 2nd in Pool B, and 1st in Pool B will play 2nd in Pool A.

The winner of each Semi Final will proceed to a Grand Final which will determine 1st and 2nd overall. The Loser of each Semi Final will proceed to a Bronze Medal Game which will determine 3rd overall.

Teams placed 3rd and 4th in each pool will proceed to a Classification Game, where 3rd in Pool A will play 3rd in Pool B, and 4th in Pool A will play 4th in Pool B. The winners of the classification games will be ranked 5th and 7th overall, and the losers will be ranked 6th and 8th overall respectively.

The team placed 5th in Pool A will be eliminated following the Round Robin and will be ranked 9th overall.

Pool A Placings and Pool B Rankings.

Should two teams finish on equal W/L following the initial round-robin, the head-to-head result between the two teams will be taken into account.

If three teams finish equal, the tie-breaker will be the points percentage between those teams only.

Games Format

Timing of Games / Amended Rules

FIBA rules shall apply, unless specified below;

Timing and Shot Clock

4 x 8 Minute Quarters, Fully Timed, 2 min quarter time, and 5 min half time. Each team will receive a MINIMUM 5 minute warmup.

24sec Shot Clocks will be used, with the clock reset to 24sec on offensive rebounds and in front-court situations.

Time Outs

Teams will be allowed 2 Time Outs in the first half, and 3 Time Outs in the second half. A maximum of 1 time out in any overtime period. The length of each Time Out will be 60 seconds.

Overtime

Should the score be tied at the end of regulation, ONE overtime period of 3 min will be played. If the score is tied after one overtime, the game shall be declared a draw. Except for the Semi and Grand Finals where multiple overtime periods of 3 min will be played until a winner is declared.



No Zone Rule

In the Spirit of the Academy Games, **Zone Defence is not permitted.**

Game Management

Should the score between two teams be greater than 20 points at any time, the use of a full-court defence (i.e. full court press) by the leading team shall no longer be implemented, and at which time the leading team is *strongly encouraged* to implement a set-offence, (as opposed to a fast-break offence) in an effort to develop the holistic game skill set of athletes.

Additionally, if the score between two teams is greater than 20 points at the start of, or during the fourth quarter, the losing coach may request to revert to a running clock for the remainder of the game. Should the score then recover to below 15 points, the above amendments shall no longer apply and the game will remain fully-timed.

Athlete Information

Injuries

A First Aid person will be available at the venue and should only be accessed through your Team Manager.

Academy Squads are advised to bring their own supplies of ICE, strapping, bandages etc.

All injuries should be reported by athletes to team managers at the conclusion of games. Team officials are responsible for the transport, treatment and care of their injured athletes.

Spirit of Play

All athletes and officials are expected to observe the “spirit of sport” requirements when participating in the Games, and adhere to the Academies’ Code of Conduct.

Athletes, coaching and support staff who do not observe these fundamental requirements will not be permitted to participate further in the Games.

Officials

Persons officiating during the Academy Games are doing so as Volunteers and are committed to assisting our athletes enjoy their participation in the Games. Officials are to be treated at all times with courtesy and respect. Basketball NSW player, coach and spectator codes of conduct will be applied at this tournament.

Abuse of match or tournament officials will not be tolerated at any time.

Should abuse of a match official take place, the game may be stopped and the person responsible removed. The match officials may also award a bench technical foul to the team bench of the offending person, whether a coach, athlete, parent or supporter.

Should any person be ejected, they shall leave the venue immediately. Following the game, it will be at the discretion of the Games Convenor whether that person shall be permitted to return for any further participation in the event.



Manager Information

Coaches/Managers Meeting

A representative of each team is expected to attend the Coach/Manager meeting on Friday evening at 6:00pm upstairs in the PCYC venue prior to matchplay commencing.

Score Sheets

Each team is to provide two (2) competent scorable officials for each game. There will be a designated spot for Managers to check the team lists and numbers for each athlete.

All referees will collect scoresheets prior to the game as well as hand them into the Games Coordinator at the conclusion of each game.

Match Officials & Scoring

- **Match Officials** - Thank you for feedback on this. While some Academies have confirmed interest, can you please reach out again and send through contact details for match officials to support the weekends play. Support is needed! Match officials will receive payment of \$30 per game! Please reach out with this information as soon as possible.
- **Score bench** - We ask that all Academies flag the necessity of the score bench for all games and this will be reliant on parents or guardians to operate. We will need a minimum of 4 people to be on duty. Please see attached roster for duty and when which Academies need to source parents or people.
- **Scoring** - PCYC have electronic scoreboards which are run through tablets. The score bench will utilise the Score Board.

Food

PCYC: There will be a café and BBQ on site at the PCYC. The stadium is also only one block away from both the MarketPlace Mall and main street which has various food options to choose from.

Preparation

Coaches/managers should ensure athletes are suitably stretched and prepared prior to the beginning of each match.

Athletes are encouraged to ensure sufficient fluid intake prior to matches.

All athletes are required to wear their full relevant Academy playing uniform.
