Spirit of Play

All athletes and officials are expected to observe the "spirit of sport" requirements when participating in the Academy Games, and adhere to the Academies' Code of Conduct.

Athletes who do not observe these fundamental requirements will not be permitted to participate further in the Academy Games.

Officials

Persons officiating, including player umpires, are doing so as volunteers and are committed to assisting all athletes in their participation in the Academy Games. Officials are to be treated with courtesy and respect at all times.

Abuse of match or tournament officials will not be tolerated at any time.

Male and Female Competition

Stage 1 - Round Robin

Each team will play in a round robin format across all competing eight teams, resulting in a total of 7 games played.

Teams will be ranked 1st through 8th based on wins and losses, followed by Goal Difference (the difference between Goals Scored, v Goals Conceded).

Should there be a tie/s following Goal Difference, the head to head result will be taken into account.

Stage 2 - Finals

The top Four teams following the Round Robin competition will proceed to the Semi Finals, with teams placing 1st and 2nd playing 4th and 3rd respectively.

The winners of each Semi Final will progress to a Grand Final to determine 1st and 2nd, with the losers progressing to a Bronze Medal match to determine 3rd and 4th.



Rules

Both Men's and Women's competition will follow the 11-a-side format, biding by the standard Hockey NSW 11-a-side rules.

All Academies are expected to be familiar with the rules, a copy of which can be downloaded from the Hockey NSW website.

Conversions

After a **Field Goal only** a team will have the opportunity to convert to gain an extra point. This is to be taken by the player who scored the goal.

Attacking player will start from 23 metre line. GK will start from behind the goal line. The attacker will have **8 seconds** to score a goal, this must be done from inside the attacking circle.

All other players must retreat to outside the half and have no part in play for the duration of the conversion. Regardless of the outcome of the conversion the match will be re-started by the **team who didn't score at the halfway line**.

If the defending team is playing without a GK and cannot sub a GK back on to defend a conversion, no conversion will take place.

Cards/Suspension

A penalty points system for cards issued will operate. Cards will attract the following point penalties:

Green Card - 2 mins 1 point Minor Yellow - 4 mins 4 points Major Yellow - 7 minutes 6 points Red Card - 10 points

The Tournament Director will suspend for one or more matches of the competition

- Any player who has accumulated 10 or more demerit points during the championship.
- Any player, reserve player, or team official who commits a Code of Conduct breach, during or after any match of the championship.

Following the serving of a suspension, a player's penalty points total shall revert to five points. The tournament director may refrain from imposing an automatic suspension in order to avoid any obvious miscarriage of justice

Team managers are required to collect a team/score card from the Tournament Coordinator (in the clubhouse) prior to every game. The card is be completed and returned to the Tournament Coordinator within 5 minutes of the game finishing.

The team captain is to sign the card at the completion of each game.







Timing of Games

All games will be centrally timed. A siren/bell will signal commencement and end of all games on both fields. Games will be **2 x 15 minute halves** with a 5 minute half time break and 5 minutes between each game.

Injuries

A First Aid representative will be available at the venue and should only be accessed through your Team Manager.

Academy Squads are advised to bring their own supplies of ICE, strapping, bandages etc.

All injuries should be reported by athletes to team managers at the conclusion of games.

Academy officials are responsible for the transport, treatment and care of their injured athletes.

Presentation

A presentation will take place as soon as practical following the Final game on Sunday Medallions will be awarded for teams finishing 1st, 2nd and 3rd in both the Men's and Women's Competition.
